John 14:1-14 New King James Version (NKJV)

"Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. ² In My Father's house are many ^[a]mansions; if *it were* not *so*, ^[b]I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also. ⁴ And where I go you know, and the way you know. ⁵ Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?"

¹² "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, because I go to My Father. ¹³ And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴ If you ^[c] ask anything in My name, I will do *it*.


Benediction


